## 'Flag on the 48' Memorial Hike

For the fifth straight year, Harborlight Montessori School students participated in the "Flags on the 48" Memorial Hike in remembrance of those who lost their lives on Sept. 11, 2001.

The group, representing Harborlight Elementary and Middle School, alumni and members of the faculty and staff, departed Beverly, Friday, Sept. 10 to make the three-hour drive to Pinkham Notch and the trail to Mount Washington.

The first four-five hour leg of the hike took the team to Appalachian Mountain Club accommodations on top of the ridge at the Lakes in the Clouds Hut, where they settled in for the night. The final ascent to the top of Mt. Washington concluded Saturday with the raising of the American flag as a tribute to those tragically lost on 9/11. Harborlight was the only school represented in this year's tribute hike.
